Chuck Cook serves as CEO of Responsive Education Solutions (ResponsiveEd) and has been an instrumental force in Texas school choice since 1998. Chuck has lead ResponsiveEd's expansion into one of the largest charter school systems in the state—operating more than 70 campuses, employing more than 2,200 educators, and serving more than 22,000 students in Grade K-12. ResponsiveEd's community schools include various models such as dropout recovery campuses, specialized mission academies, and STEM high schools.

Additionally, Chuck founded the Foundation School for Autism in San Antonio, the first tuition-free charter school for students with autism in the state of Texas. Chuck's vision is to see ResponsiveEd continue its expansion into a national network of 500 high quality, character-focused schools of choice, serving 125,000 students.
