

Public charter schools are losing classroom dollars to drainage fees

The **Problem**

Unlike traditional school districts, public charter schools are having to spend public funds intended for students on local drainage fees.

The **Solution**

Ensure public charter schools receive the same treatment as ISDs for drainage fees. Exempting public charter schools from drainage fees will allow them to keep more of their limited funds and use them where they are needed most, in the classroom supporting students and teachers.



SB 674 will:

- ✓ Exempts public charter schools from municipal drainage fees to the same extent that ISDs are exempt.
